Teleki Castle was where Ken and I first met the children from the TB Preventorium in 2007. It was taken over under the communist regime and no one was allowed into the Centre to visit the children until communism fell in 1989.

In 2011 it was returned to the Teleki family. Mrs Teleki showed us around the castle. It is a beautiful
