After the children moved to a smaller facility in February, the institution was closed indefinitely in March due to Covid-19.

However, as one door closed, another one immediately opened for us. Ilona maintained phone contact with the families of these children during Romania's lock-down and afterwards regularly visited them to see how they were getting on and what help we could offer them.

It has always been the intention of HANNAH to have access to the families of the children, to offer to work alongside them to help them to be able to care for their children. God has now given us this opportunity, which we are grateful for and pray that we will be a real blessing to the children and their families and together make a big difference in their lives for a more positive future.

Some Recent Updates
