Partnering For Safety

Partnering for Safety is an assessment and planning framework that is developed collaboratively with children, families and their networks.

In the lead up to the training in June it was wonderful to see God's hand constantly at work. In spite of what it looked like at times beforehand, on the day, we got the participant numbers and the funds we needed. Everything was as we had dared to believe it would be, and beyond. Attendees included social workers from NGO's, local communities (Mayor's offices), and state organisations. It was encouraging to hear people's heart for their work. Kati reported "All participants were there because they would like to make a difference in the lives of families and children. For all of them it is a calling, not just a job."

Two Directors from their respective organisations would like all their staff to be trained in this model. One of them said "I feel so good when I am at this training, I don't know why." She wants to see if she can include it in her training budget for 2024. We intend to discuss possibilities with her when we make the trip from NZ to Romania later this year.

Cath also spent a day one to one with Kati, focusing on her work with HANNAH families, discussing cases and going over tricky situations. It was a great encouragement and inspiration for Kati to spend time with someone with such expertise.

Good News! One of our HANNAH girls ('Dee') has been accepted into an NGO children's home from where she can attend school. She previously lived in an institution for long periods of time. Since returning home she has lived in difficult family circumstances and was unable to attend school. She is really keen to learn.

Thank you to Netherlands Organisation - 5 Loaves 2 Fish, who are sponsoring her accommodation.

None of this happened without hard work on Kati's part. She built up a relationship of trust with the family, persisting and believing in them to eventually make the right decision for their daughter. This is a big change for them because Dee was helping look after the younger siblings at home. We therefore also want to acknowledge Dee's mother and step father for signing the papers for the initial 3 month trial period (with a view to extending it).

Kati needs to locate Dee's education records before

she can be enrolled at a school. Please pray for this very important step.
